Rules and Conditions of Entry

1. The landowners, organisers and officials shall not be held responsible for anything that might happen to competitors, onlookers, their property, servants or animals in connections with or arriving at these competitions. It shall be a condition of entry that each entrant agrees to indemnify the promoters against loss, damage or legal action. Competitors are reminded that they are personally responsible for any damage done by the horse(s) they are riding at the competitions.
2. Hard hats to British Standard EN1384 and PASO 15 must be worn at all times when mounted.
3. Horses and ponies must be four years and over.
4. Dogs must be kept on leads.
5. No refund of entry fees will be made except on receipt of a vet's or doctor's certificate.
6. The competitions to be held under the guidance of the BHS Rules. In all cases the Judge's decision is final. Any objection must be accompanied by a deposit of £20 within half an hour of the said offence. The deposit will only be returned if the decision is upheld.
7. The organisers reserve the right to cancel the show, alter the classes, times or any of the published information.

Please Note there will be no vet, farrier or ambulance in attendance.
